Sophomores and juniors with a 3.5 GPA or higher, received qualifying scores on eligible administrations of the PSAT/NMSQT[®], PSAT[™] 10, or AP[®] Exams, and identify as Black/African American, Latinx/Hispanic, Indigenous, or attend high school in a rural area or small town may be eligible for one or more of these programs:

- African American Recognition Program
- Hispanic Recognition Program
- Indigenous Recognition Program
- Rural and Small Town Recognition Program

Application Timeline

Early Spring

Application opens! BigFuture invites eligible students to apply for recognition. If you don't receive an invite but believe you're eligible, you can nominate yourself. Visit bigfuture.org/NRP to apply.

June 12

Deadline for all students to apply. This deadline will not be extended.

Early Fall

If you receive recognition after applying, you'll receive an email with instructions to access your official certificate of recognition. Counselors receive an email with a list of their school's awardees.
